- 2. I have been diagnosed with COVID-19 and have no symptoms.
- 3. I live with someone who was diagnosed with COVID-19 (this person has symptoms).
- 4. I live with someone who was diagnosed with COVID-19 (this person does not have symptoms).
- 5. I was in close contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19.

Released from quarantine:

14 days after your last

I 4 days after your last contact with the diagnosed person
