

Isolation and Quarantine Release Timeframes

1. I have been diagnosed with COVID-19 and have symptoms.
2. I have been diagnosed with COVID-19 and have no symptoms.
3. I live with someone who was diagnosed with COVID-19 (this person has symptoms).
4. I live with someone who was diagnosed with COVID-19 (this person does not have symptoms).
5. I was in close contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19.

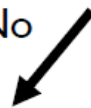
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**I live with someone who was never sick,

person completes a 10-day
isolation**

Released from quarantine:

**14 days after your last
contact with the diagnosed
person**
