FSET is a free program that helps FoodShare members build their skills and find a job. To enroll in FSET, you must qualify for FoodShare benefits through the state.

W2 is a work program for adults willing to engage in work activities. You must have minor children in the home to qualify for the program. With the W-2 Program, you may be eligible for a monthly cash payment while you participate in activities.
