#### SUSPECT CASE:

**EXCLUDE FOR 10 DAYS** SINCE SYMPTOM ONSET AND 24 HOURS FEVER FREE AND OTHER SYMPTOMS IMPROVING. ENSURE PH IS NOTIFIED. **Household Members:** The best practice from a public health perspective is to exclude household members for 14 days since last exposure to ill individual. However, the school nurse may consider if these symptoms are different from baseline of the ill student
